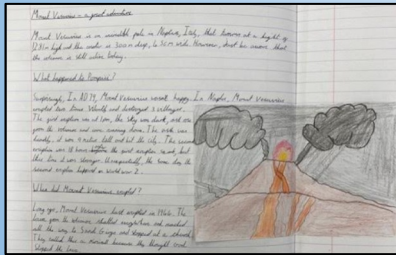




Africa - Year 5 with Ms Gilham: Spring 1
