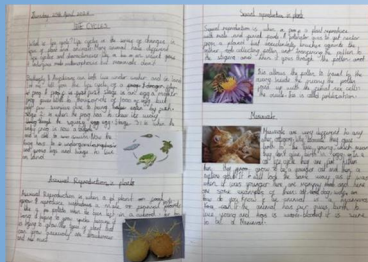




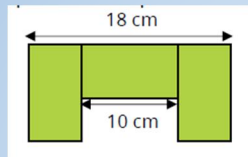
Africa - Year 5 with Ms Gilham: Summer 1
