<u>Safeguarding</u> <u>Children's Questionnaire</u>



Our children have recently completed a questionnaire about themselves, their learning and behaviour.

The children were overwhelmingly positive about their experiences at school, across all areas. Examples include:

At Spixworth Infant School, 99% of children said they felt safe at school and had a trusted adult to talk to in school, if they were worried. 100% of children said they were happy in school most of the time and 99% would recommend the school to a new friend.

At Woodland View, 94% said they feel safe and have a trusted adult they would speak to in school. 99% said they had a positive, respectful relationship with their class teacher and 96% said the school promotes respect for different people and communities.

Your child's views are important to us. We will always listen. If your child shares a worry with us, we will let you know (unless this would put them at risk of harm).
